Staff Sergeant Roberto R. Rodriguez is a Noncommissioned Officer in Charge, Wing Occupational Safety, 22d Air Refueling Wing, McConnell Air Force Base, Kansas, one of the Air Force's three core tanker wings. SSgt Rodriguez advises the Wing and Groups on all mishap prevention, provides customer service support to over 4,000 enlisted and civilian personnel assigned to five groups comprised of 17 squadrons, 14 wing staff agencies, two detachments and five geographically separated units.

SSgt Rodriguez grew up in North Lauderdale, Florida. He is married with two children. SSgt Rodriguez enlisted in the Air Force in November 2010. In April 2011, he graduated from the Air Transportation Course at Fort Lee, Virginia. His assignments have taken him to Texas, Virginia, California, South Korea, Qatar, Germany and now Kansas. Prior to his current assignment, SSgt Rodriguez has served as the Senior Controller, 726 Air Mobility Squadron, Spangdahlem Air Base, Germany. While in Germany he was instrumental to the transportation of 14,700 passengers and 15,000 tons of cargo on 1,800 missions culminating in the Wing winning its 7th consecutive Meritorious Unit Award. SSgt Rodriguez has served at both Host and Deployed Bases; he continues to strive for excellence through education and training.

SSgt Rodriguez's education includes Basic Military Training Course, Lackland AFB, Texas, Air Transportation Apprentice Course, Airman Leadership School, an Associate of Applied Science in Logistics, Senior Enlisted Joint Professional Military Education, Occupational Safety Apprentice Course, and an Associate of Applied Science in Occupational Safety.
