David Praiswater has been employed at Washburn Tech since 2005 as a Construction Technology Instructor. This program introduces the students to 10 different aspects of the construction trades by building a construction model within the lab. No one graduates as an expert in any of these fields, however graduates are able to communicate well with hiring personnel and perform basic construction tasks that are needed in the industry. Praiswater's graduates have good soft skills that open doors for real career training to begin. He has been an authorized OSHA trainer since 2010 and presents the 30-hour instruction required by the Washburn Tech Construction Division. Praiswater has been an NCCER Craft Instructor since 1996 and continues to teach their curriculum in his classroom. Since 2008 he has been the SkillsUSA Lead Advisor on campus and has managed Washburn Tech's state and national competitions. During his tenure the school has amassed 793 medals in over 25 different programs on campus. This year marks a career milestone for Praiswater of providing educational services for 40 years.
