ORDER TO AMEND

Now, on the 14th day of June 2022 the above captioned matter came on for consideration before the Public Employees Relations Board.

The Petition for Unit Clarification or Amendment was submitted by both parties, pursuant to K.A.R. 84-2-7. According to the Petition of the parties, and after consideration by the Board pursuant to K.S.A. 75-4327(c), the appropriate unit for the Wichita State University as previously ordered in UE-20-1973 shall be amended and comprised of the following classifications, in accordance with K.S.A. 75-4327(e) and K.A.R. 84-2-6:



Specialist, Custodial Lead, Custodial Supervisor, Electrical Assistant, Electrician Maintenance, Electrician Licensed Journeyman, Electrician Lead, Electronics Technician, Small Engine Mechanic, Equipment Operator, Landscaper, Shipping and Receiving Clerk, Shipping and Receiving Clerk Lead, Inventory Control Specialist, Inventory Control Specialist Lead, Maintenance Technician, Maintenance Technician Senior, Laboratory Technician-Biology, Lock System Specialist, Auto Shop Assistant, Auto Shop Specialist, Auto Shop Certified, Painting Assistant, Painter Maintenance, Painter Senior, Pipefitter, Plumbing Assistant, Plumber Maintenance, Plumber Licensed Journeyman, Plumber Lead,







RIGHT TO REQUEST HEARING


