**ORDER TO AMEND**

This petition for Unit Clarification or Amendment submitted by the Labor International Union of North America (LiUNA) Local 1290 PE has the effect of modifying the name of employee organization (Petitioner) and also modifying the list of job classifications included in the bargaining unit as previously ruled on in 75-UCA-7-1993. Specifically, amended unit would include and exclude the following:

Include: Boiler Operator, Boiler Operator Sr., Boiler Technician, Carpenter, Carpenter Sr., Custodian, Electronics Technician, Electrician, Electrician Sr., Equipment Mechanic, Equipment Mechanic Sr., Equipment Operator, Food Service Worker, General Maintenance and Repair Technician, General Maintenance and Repair Technician Sr., General Maintenance Worker, HVAC Technician, HVAC Technician Sr., Instrumentation Technician, Landscape Worker, Landscape Worker Senior, Locksmith, Locksmith Sr., Mason, Mason Sr., Painter, Painter Sr., Parking Officer – Parking, Plumber, Plumber Sr., Pump Mechanic, Sheet Metal Worker, Sheet Metal Worker Sr., Steamfitter, Steamfitter Sr., Storekeeper, Welder, and Welder Sr.

Exclude: All other classifications not specifically included above.

Pursuant to the mutual agreement of the parties, it is hereby ordered to adopt the name change of the unit and job classifications as previously cited.
