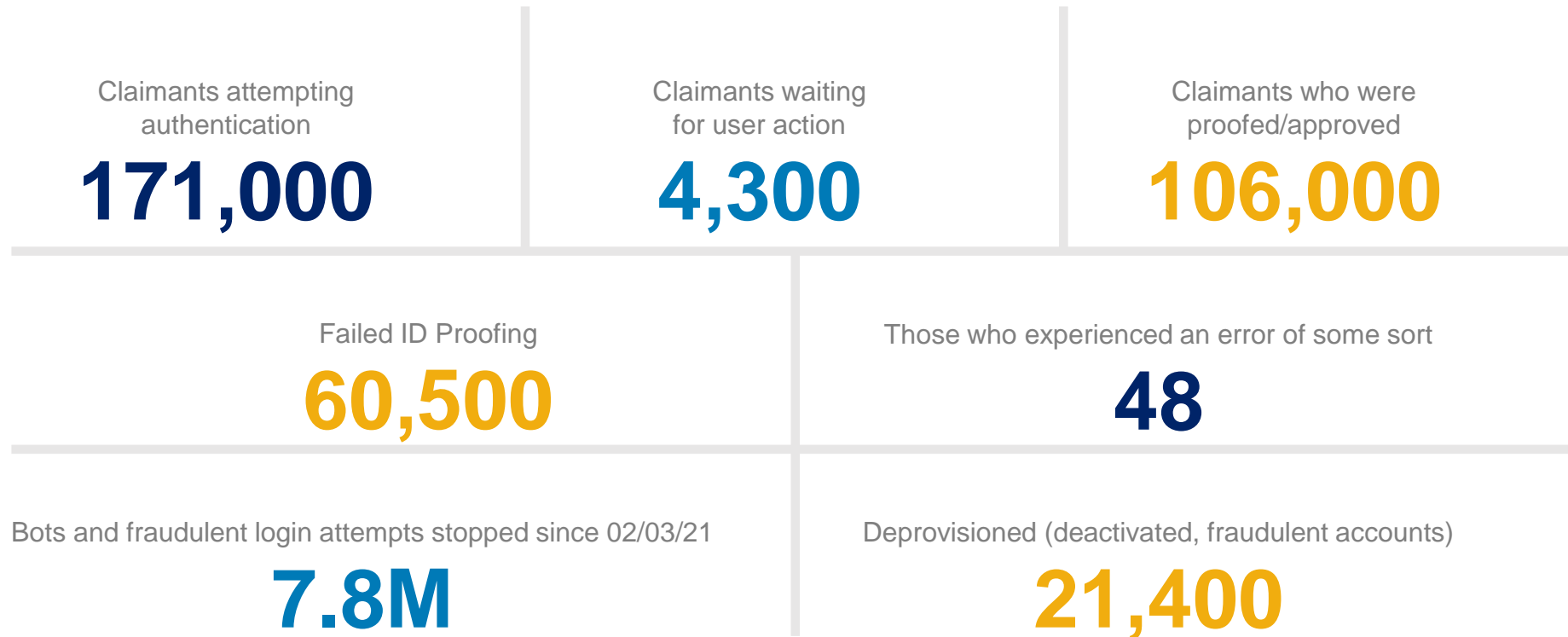

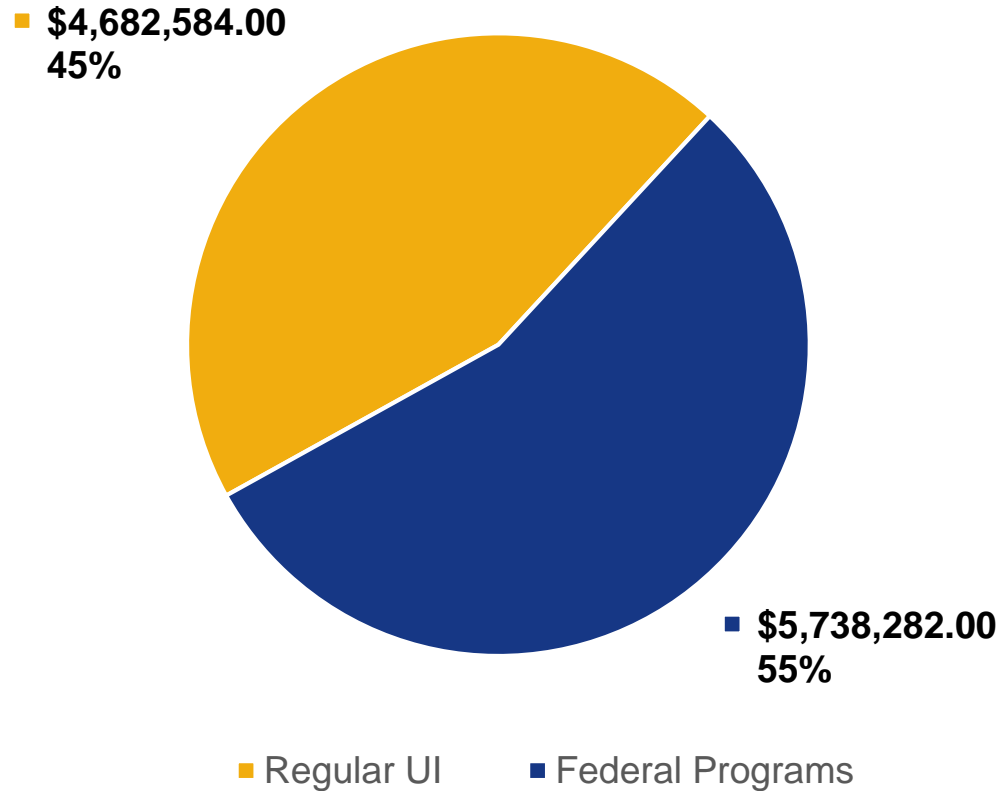

As of the week ending 06/12/21

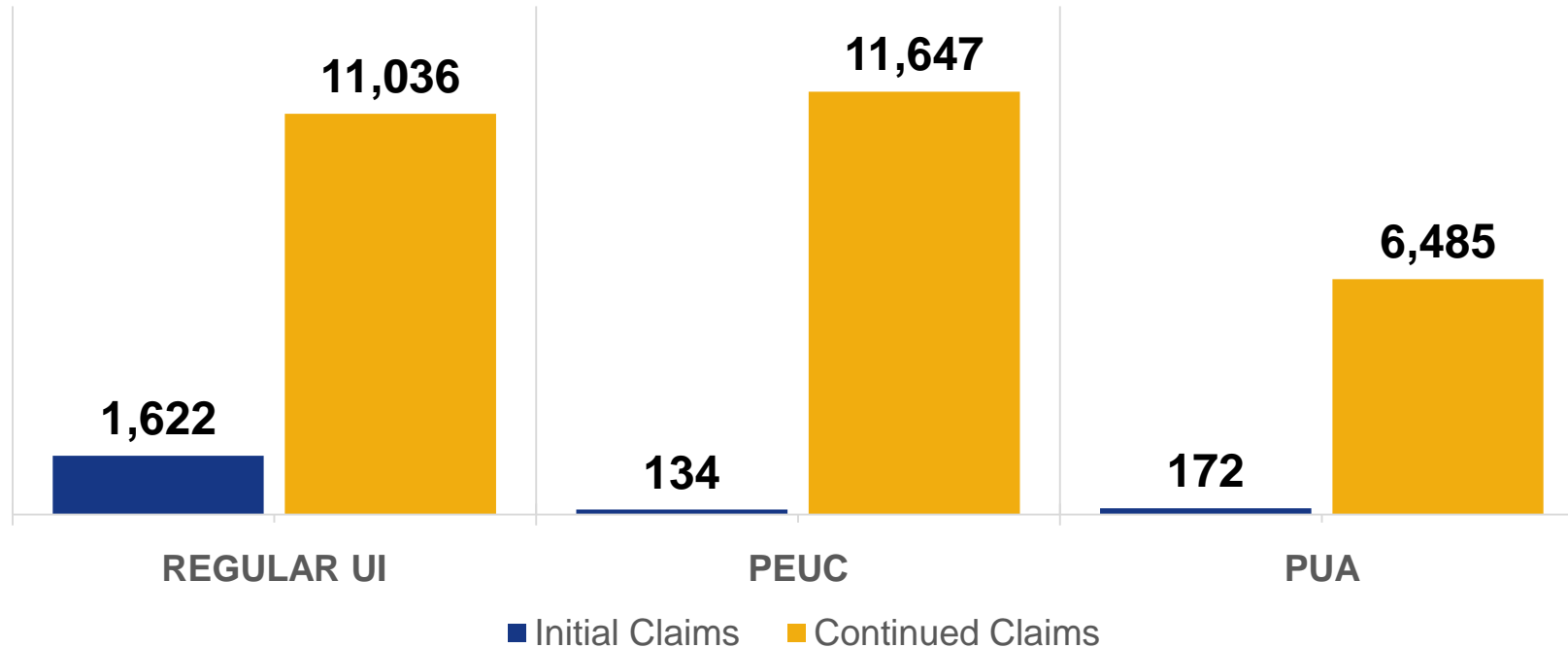


**FPUC\***  
**\$8,591,968.00**

\*FPUC is a \$300 payment each week in addition to other unemployment benefits an individual may receive. Claimants who are eligible for at least \$1 of their underlying unemployment compensation benefit amount are eligible for the additional \$300 FPUC benefit payment. If you are eligible, you will automatically receive the FPUC payment. You must file a weekly claim for the underlying unemployment benefit you are currently receiving to qualify for FPUC payments

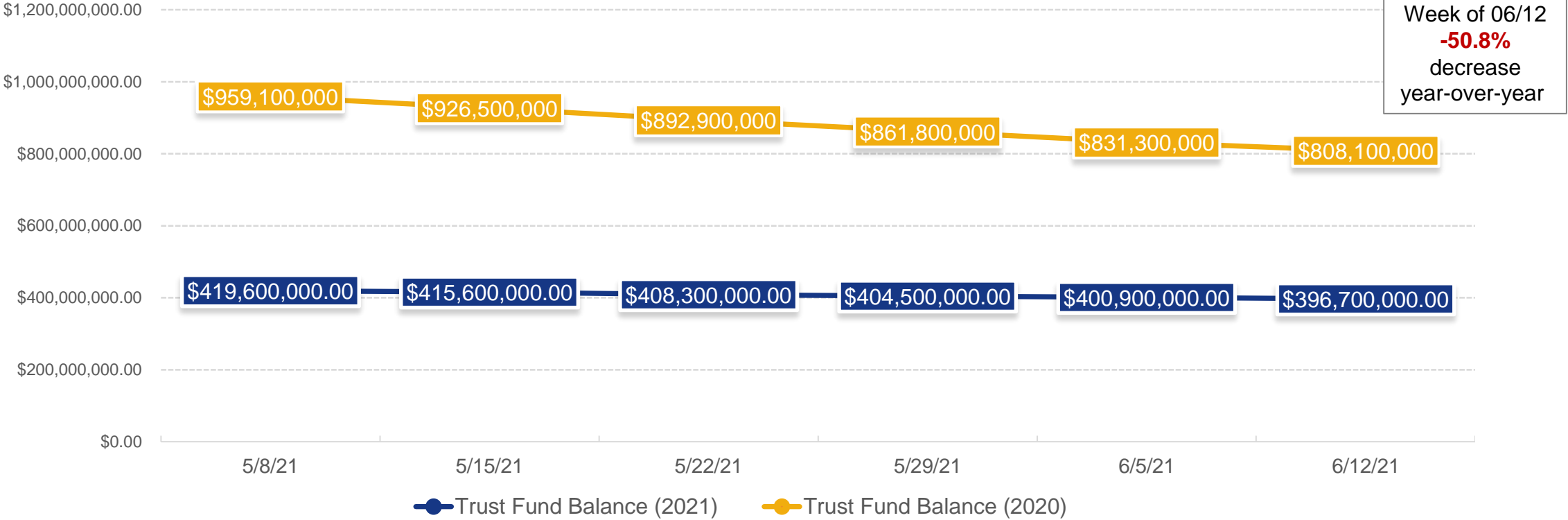
# Claim Totals

*Initial and continued claims as of the week ending 06/12/21*



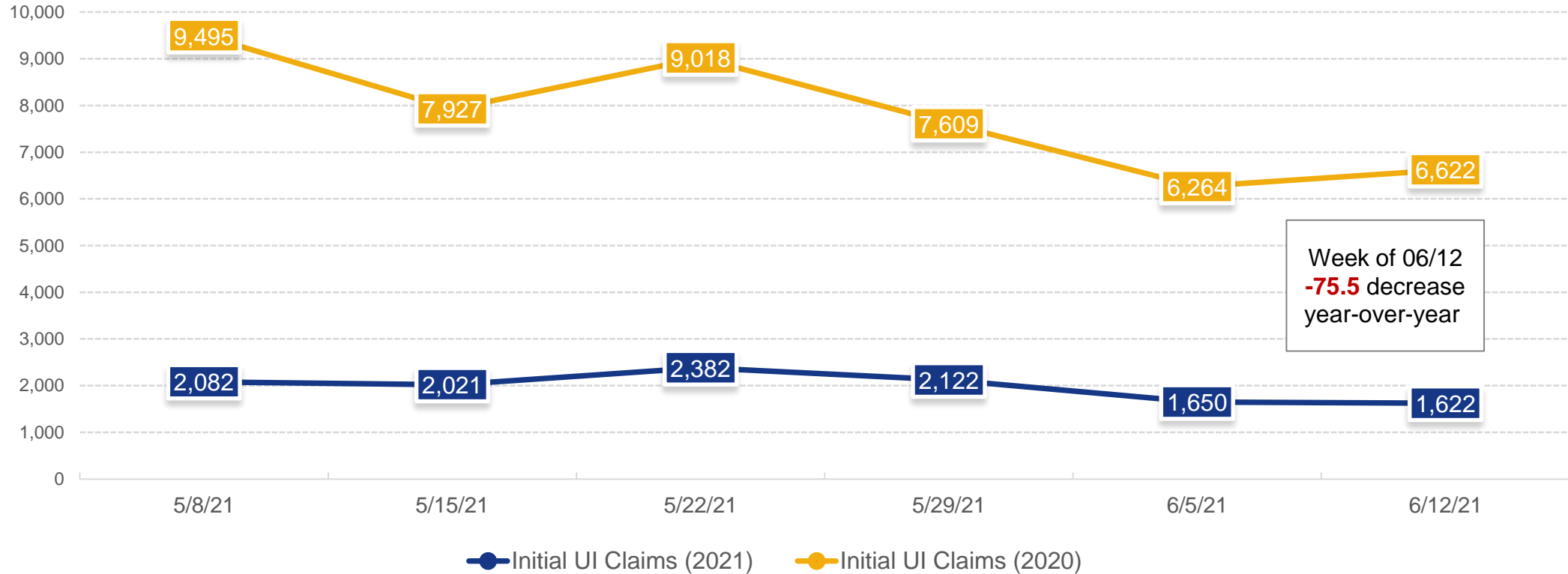
# Trust Fund Balances

Six week view, year-over-year, ending 06/12/21



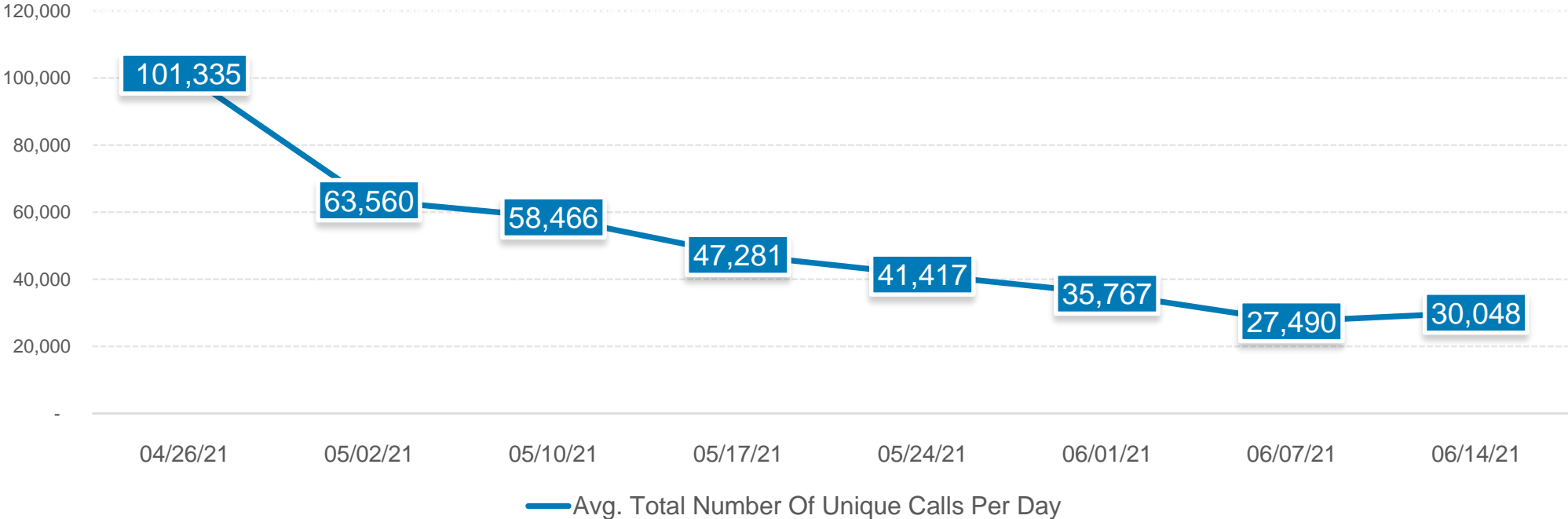
# Initial UI Claims
