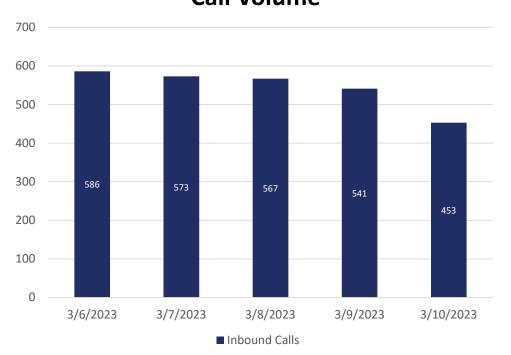

Call Volume

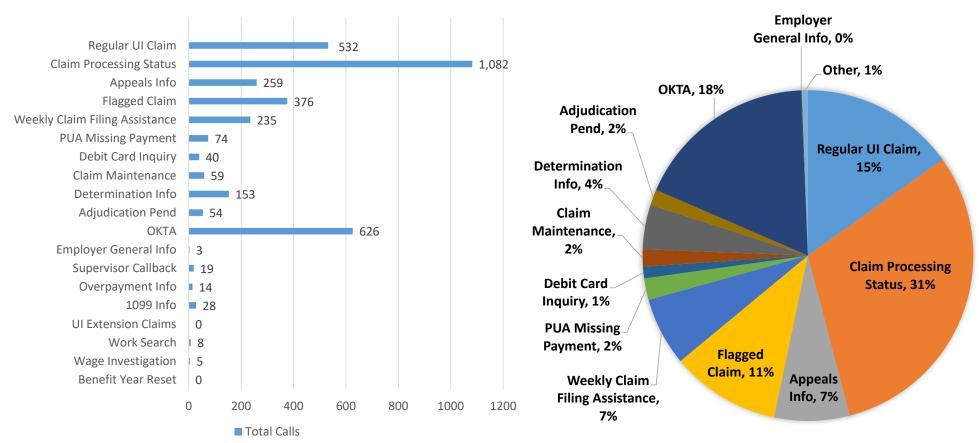

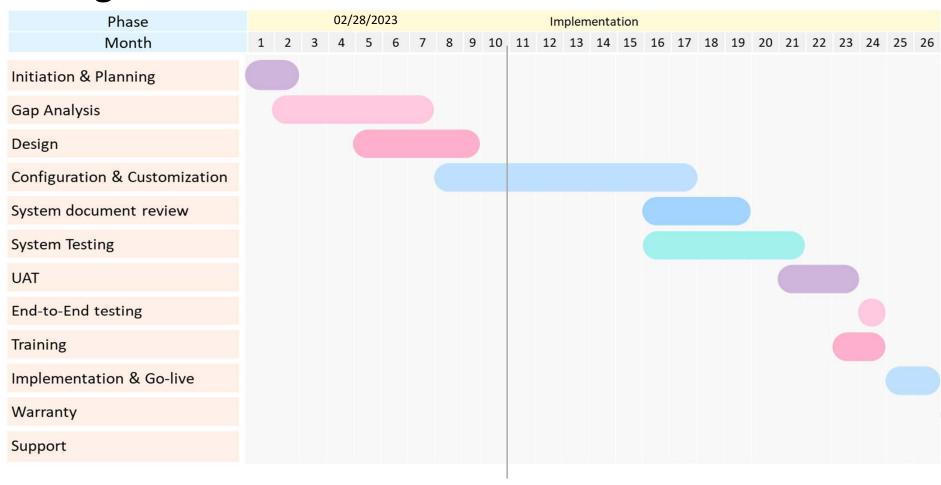
