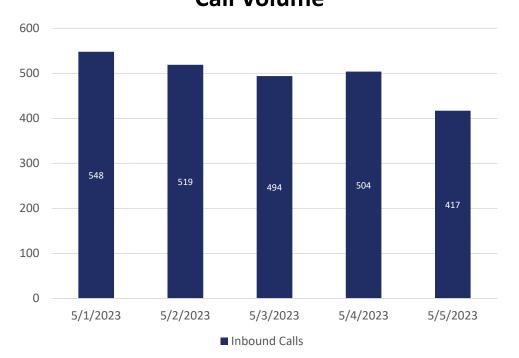

#### **Call Volume**

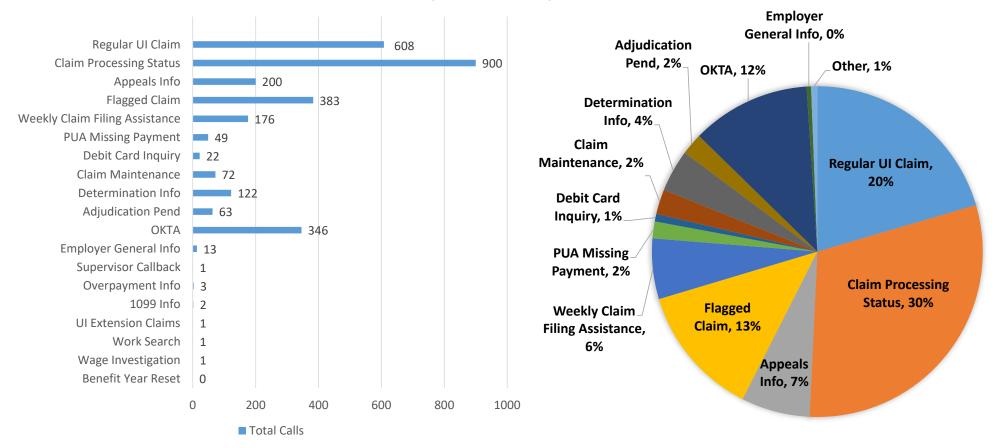

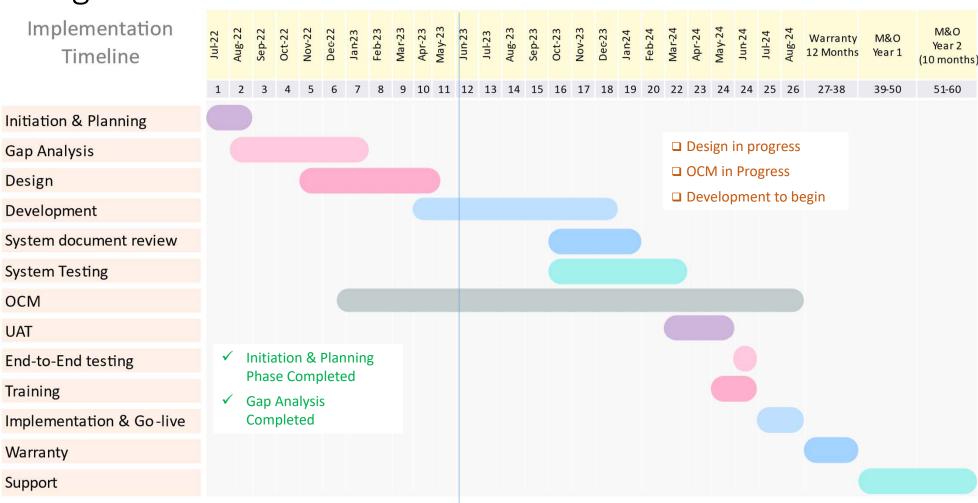
